What's Required for the Temporary Permit:

- Proof of 21 Years Old & Resident of Bethlehem
- Certificate of Completion with (1) **copy** of DESPP APPROVED Pistol Safety Course (NRA Basic Pistol)
- Proof of Citizenship or legal resident (Alien Registration Card / VISA / I-94)
- Application (Form DPS-799) ***Must Be Notarized.**
- **\$10 Cash or Check** Payable to "Town Of Bethlehem" (Processing Fee)
- **\$12.00 Check** payable to "Treasurer State of Connecticut" (FBI fingerprint background check)
- **\$50.00 Check** payable to "Treasurer State of Connecticut" (State Fingerprint Check)
- **\$70.00 Check** payable to Town of Bethlehem (Temporary Permit)

**Note: if you are unable to come in on Saturdays, you may try during the week if the Resident Trooper is on duty and available.*

No appointments can be made.

Once the fingerprint card results are received from the State and FBI, and a temporary permit is approved, applicant will be notified that temporary permit may be picked up which is **valid for 60 Days**. You may then carry but **NOT** purchase until you get State Permit.

Applicant needs to take the temporary permit, a \$70.00 Check payable to "Treasurer State of Connecticut" and either a birth certificate, voter's registration, or passport, in addition to a picture ID such as a Driver's License to CT Department of Emergency Services & Public Protection located at: **1111 Country Club Road, Middletown CT, 06457 (I-91 Exit 20)**
