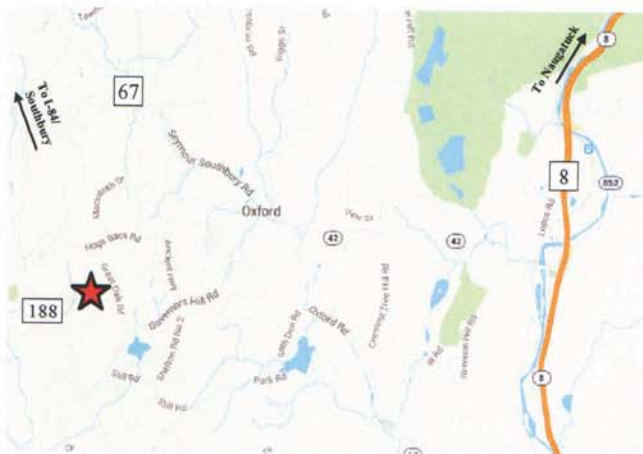

Directions to Collection Site

From I-84 West: Take Exit 16. Turn left at end of exit ramp onto CT-188 S. Follow CT-188 S for approximately 5.4 miles. Turn Left on Hogs Back Rd. Turn Right on Great Oak Rd. Event will be on the right.

From I-84 East: Take Exit 15. Turn Right onto CT-67 S. Turn Right onto CT-188 S. Turn left on Hogs Back Rd. Turn right on Great Oak Rd. Event will be on the right.

From CT-8 South: Take Exit 24. Turn right to follow N Main St. onto CT-42 W. Continue on CT-42 and turn right on CT-67. Turn left on Governors Hill Rd. Turn right on Great Oak Rd. Event will be on the left.

Household Hazardous Waste

What to Bring:

Mercury and Mercury thermometers, Drain & Oven Cleaners, Upholstery Cleaners, Poisons, Insecticides, Wood Cleaners, Aerosols, Metal Polishers, Pool & Photo Chemicals, Automotive Cleaners & Fluids, Grease & Rust Solvents, Alkaline Batteries, and Fluorescent Bulbs.

What NOT to Bring:

No Auto Batteries, **No** Motor Oil, **No** Radioactive or Medical Waste, **No** Asbestos, **No** Explosives, and **No** Empty Fire Extinguishers, **No** Compressed Gas Cylinders, **No** Lead Paint Chips.

Limit of **50 lbs.** of waste per vehicle. Commercial and industrial waste will only be accepted through prior arrangement. Small quantity generators (CESQGs) please contact COGCNV if interested in participating in HHW collection.

Paint Collection

Beginning July 1, 2013, Connecticut instituted a statewide paint recycling program known as PaintCare. PaintCare provides free recycling of architectural paint by placing a small fee on newly purchased paint. Acceptable paints will be collected at HHW events.

Acceptable Paints:

Interior and exterior architectural paints, latex, acrylic, water-based, alkyd, oil-based, enamel, deck coatings, floor paints, primers, sealers, undercoatings, field and lawn paints stains, shellacs, lacquers, varnishes, urethanes (single component), waterproofing sealers (except tar or bitumen based), metal coatings, rust preservatives.

Containers **larger** than **5** gallons will **not** be accepted.
