MINUTES: (Unapproved)

Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. by Pat Ueberbacher. Minutes of the meeting of May 17, 2016 were approved for filing.

LaBonne contribution cards: Pat reported that the Board of Selectman approved our request to expend \$450.00 from our unspent budget money for cash contribution cards to be used by seniors in need for the purchase of meat, dairy or staples from LaBonnes. Program had 100% success rate. LaBonne's has home delivery service for seniors, too.

Yard spring cleanup work: Pat reported that we had no eligible call backs to use this service.

Pat submitted a summary of the Senior Commission to the preparation of the Annual Town Report.

Board of Selectman reduced Senior Commission budget from \$1,000.00 to \$500.00 for next fiscal year, which sum should be satisfactory for the commission's needs.

We reviewed various pamphlets from Southbury senior fair for potential use in Bethlehem. It was noted that Painted Pony is ceasing the Senior Dine as of July 15, 2016. Pony still has a \$9.00 all inclusive lunch special.

Bob to investigate and file if possible a grant application to The Thomaston Savings Bank Foundation to seek \$2,000.00 grant for use in finding a consultant to investigate the goal of obtaining more senior housing in Bethlehem.


